Review my Benefits in Workday

It's your annual benefits check-up! Review carefully what you are enrolled in. Do you still like those plans? Are all your dependents enrolled too? You didn't forget someone, right? If you have no updates to make – then you are in the clear. See you at next year's open enrollment!

Hold on. I forgot about my FSA.

Yep! If you are participating now and want to continue in 2019 – you must re-enroll in the FSA in Workday. Oh, and don't cut up that TASC debit card you have. It will re-load with your new enrollment amount.

I actually need to make changes (besides the FSA).

No problem! Our Open Enrollment website will have quick reference guides to walk you through Workday enrollment. See page 2 for the link.

I just remembered. I want to change my doctor.

You can do this at any time as long as the new physician is in the network of the medical plan you are already enrolled in. Just call the number on the back of your medical card.
