PART A
HOSPITAL INSURANCE

INPATIENT HOSPITAL CARE

- Hospital stays
- Home health services (following an acute stay)
- Hospice care
- Skilled nursing care
- Transplants

PART B
MEDICAL INSURANCE

DOCTOR & OUTPATIENT VISITS

- Doctor visits
- Home health services (not following an acute stay)
- Ambulance services
- Outpatient physical, speech, and occupational therapy
- Outpatient surgeries
- Durable medical equipment
- X-rays

PART C
MEDICARE ADVANTAGE

COVERS SAME BENEFITS AS PART A & B

May include additional coverage for:

- Prescription drug coverage
- Dental, vision, and hearing services
- Health and wellness programs

Offered through private insurance companies

PART D
DRUG COVERAGE

RX DRUG COVERAGE

- Each plan offers its own formulary
- Costs vary based on brand vs. generic medications
- Costs vary based on drug tiers
