
Overview of the CCCCO Guided Pathways Initiative

- ▶ First-year work plan (Spring 2018-Summer 2019) of a five-year initiative
- ▶ Work plan due to the CCCCO **March 30, 2018**
- ▶ Submission of plan initiates funding for colleges to implement pathways
 - ▶ \$848,158 over 5 years for Cuyamaca
 - ▶ \$1,441,347 over 5 years for Grossmont
- ▶ Work plan allows colleges to identify major activities to advance the College's readiness for adopting a guided pathways framework
- ▶ Work plan is broken down into 14 areas per the Pathways Self-Assessment submitted to the CCCCO in December
 - ▶ Inquiry
 - ▶ Design
 - ▶ Implementation

Cuyamaca Pathways Work Plan Highlights

- ▶ Inquiry
 - ▶ Integrate pathways momentum points into college KPIs and engage governance groups with pathways data
 - ▶ Integrate pathways framework into program review and resource allocation processes
- ▶ Design
 - ▶ Fully organize programs into meta-majors and redesign college catalog
 - ▶ Complete academic maps for all programs of study
- ▶ Implementation
 - ▶ Scale up services piloted in Title III and Title V grants
 - ▶ Expand and fully integrate student support services and engagement activities into the student experience
 - ▶ Provide professional development to advance SLO-centric instruction

Grossmont Pathways Work Plan Highlights

Inquiry:

- Cross-functional inquiry teams
- Integrated planning/resource allocation to use data & GP frame.

Design - Curricular and Systemic

- Inclusive, transparent decision-making; inter-segmental alignment
- Clear program requirements; Improved Basic Skills to enter the path.

Implementation

- Professional development aligned with strategic goals
- Proactive, integrated student supports and technology infrastructure.
